# How do I lower my prescription drug costs?

#### Ask your physician about generic drugs

A generic drug is a version of a brand drug. According to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), compared to the brand drug, a generic:

- is chemically the same
- works the same in the body
- is just as safe and effective
- meets the same standards set by the FDA
- often costs much less

Example: rosuvastatin (generic) is the same drug as Crestor® (brand)

#### Contact your new participating FirstChoice™ pharmacy

Inform your new participating FirstChoice<sup>™</sup> pharmacy that you want to transfer your prescriptions from your old pharmacy. You will need the name, strength, and prescription number of each prescription, along with the phone number of your old pharmacy. You can accomplish this by calling, visiting the new pharmacy in person, or if your new pharmacy offers the technology, by using online services such as a website or mobile app.

What information will the pharmacy need to facilitate the transfer? Your new pharmacy will need your health insurance information, and perhaps some personal information as well. Typically, your new pharmacy will request:

- Health insurance card
- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Phone number
- Possible allergies you may have

#### How long will it take to complete the transfer?

The amount of time your new pharmacy needs can depend on how many prescriptions need to be moved over, possibly 1-3 business days. When the time comes to pickup your prescription(s), please bring your insurance card with you to the pharmacy.

# Creating an Online PPS Account

# Ordering New or Transferred Prescriptions

Once you have added a patient to your online PPS account, it is easy to add new prescriptions or transfer prescriptions from another pharmacy

- 1. Select **Register** from the upper right-hand corner of the PPS website
- 2. Enter your email address and create a password
- 3. Select Create Account
- Select Add a Prescription from the left navigation menu and follow the on-screen steps for PPS to request a new prescription from your doctor or a transferred prescription from another pharmacy
- 2. Your doctor can send a new prescription to PPS by electronic prescribing, fax, phone, or mail
- 3. Or, if your doctor has given you a paper prescription, you should mail it to PPS at:

Generally, it takes about 3-5 business days for PPS to contact your prescriber or pharmacy to obtain your prescription(s). If you requested a fill of these prescriptions, they will be sent as soon as the prescriptions are received and filled.

- 4. Select View Member Page
- 5. Under **Search For Medications**, type the name of your medication and click **Search**


